A Legacy of Care: Help at Home Celebrates 15 Years



Members of VNA's Help at Home staff were recognized at the all-agency meeting in May as the agency celebrated the program's 15th anniversary. Due to busy and varied schedules, it is often challenging for many of the Help at Home staff to make it to the all-agency meetings. Their presence made the occasion that much more special.



VNA's Help at Home program is celebrating 15 years of service to the community, but two of the program's staff have been at VNA for almost double that. Carolyn, CNA/CHHA/RA, has been caring for the community for 28 years. She says her favorite aspect of working at VNA is "just working with the patients. I like going into their homes and the one-on-one experience that I have with them." Pat, LPN, has been at VNA for 29 years and has been the Help at Home manager since 2011. In addition to managing all of VNA's aide staff, Pat is also the chairperson of the Safety Committee, a member of the Social and Ethics Committees, assists with VNA's flu vaccination clinics and so much more! These incredibly dedicated healthcare professionals are VNA's fifth and fourth longest serving employees, respectively.
